

Seagull Water. Swedish working group 030410. Summary.

1. Reports from

- regional water conference in Sweden
- regional water conference, expert meeting and study visits in Klaipeda
- Swedish water administration. The Regional Council in Kalmar County has written to the Environmental Ministry concerning
 - a/ the advantages using already existing organisations (as Lyckeby river water association) for implementation of the WFD instead of creating new bodies and
 - b/ a suggestion to place a new water authority in Kalmar.
- Kalmar University will be responsible for an external evaluation of the activities in Swedish the pilot area. Questionnaire in the beginning and in the end of the project time.

2. Future work

Lyckeby river pilot area:

- Continued activities. Information to citizens, pupils and teachers.
- Translation of Swedish homepage to English? Description to other pilot areas.
- 3 months report to other pilot areas.

Other:

- Description of the region in relation to the WFD, as an input to the common Seagull report. Ready May 2003.
- Consequences on physical planning? Report from a meeting between the municipalities in Kronoberg County and Kronoberg County Administration Board will be spread within the Swedish part of Seagull Water.
- Invitation to other water projects within the Swedish ERB area; their project leaders are welcome to take part in the Seagull Water WG.
- Sewage from private houses on the countryside – is there a need of special activities within this subject?
- Among the most important at the moment: Characteristics of the river basins will take place during 2004 – what will be the consequences for the municipalities?
- The Emå river (Jönköping, Kronoberg and Kalmar County) may be a pilot area for characteristics of river basin areas. The Seagull project wants to take part in this pilot project, as observer or in other way.
- The National Board of Housing, Building and Planning has preliminary asked a representative of Seagull Water to take part in a working group about WFD and planning.
- Contacts with the Environmental department and The National Environmental Agency, promoting the Seagull-project.
- Meetings with our ERB partners.
